## TESTIMONY

On Saturday, 17th April 2021, at about 12:15 p.m., I was making lunch for the family when my phone rang. So, I stepped out to take the call, then later engaged in a little chat with my husband who was in the sitting room with our kids. It was not up to seven minutes when my husband said he heard a popping sound from the kitchen, and asked if I was roasting corn. I laughed and said no, then I quickly made my way back to the kitchen.

When I opened the door, I saw that a section of the kitchen was on fire, not up to a meter away from our gas cooker which was still cooking, and the gas cylinder which was also in the kitchen. The fire, with no known cause till date, had consumed an old amber basket which was stuffed with polythene bags I use for trash, a rack of glass cups and an empty groundnut bottle, which had apparently made the popping sound my husband heard.

I quickly called his attention and he ran to get the fire extinguisher which we discovered was not working. I was confused. Then the thought that there was no fear here, came to me. So, I quickly turned off gas cooker and the cylinder, picked up a bucket of water at the corner and poured it on the flame which was already bringing down the PVC ceiling.

To the glory of God, the fire miraculously went down. Who knows what would have happened if the gas cylinder had exploded because a week earlier, a neighbour at the next building had a similar experience with her stove and was hospitalised as the fire burnt half of her body.

I thank the on-time God for showing up in my case! People came, saw the impact of the fire, and said it could only be God. No smell of smoke! I also remembered our Psalm 91 faith confession, emphases on verses 4, 10, 11 and 15. I also saw Psalm 121:1-8 which has been our daily routine Scripture become a reality that day.

Thank you, our dear Pastor Nkechi Ene, for the undiluted Word of God you load us with daily. Thank you, Pastor Sola, for your prayers, my amiable zonal pastor, Pastor Dupe, my FOG leader and members of my FOG for your visitations and calls at that time. We are grateful for your show of love and kindness.

Thank God for His amazing grace upon me and my household. God is big in me! God is big in you and God is big in TCC!
