I was interviewed and days later, I was called to come and pick my admission letter. My joy knew no bounds, when I realised that I had miraculously gained admission into the home. During, my counselling session. I was asked what I wanted and I chose school.

In the home, I was shown agape love, we were properly taken care of, we were taught the undiluted Word of God by the assistant Pastors who took turns to teach us weekly. I wrote WAEC in the home and to the glory of God, I passed. I graduated from the Scarlet Thread Transition Home, where I wrote JAMB and came out in flying colours. I then gained admission into the University.

I was awarded scholarship by the Church to study the course of my choice for four consecutive years. Throughout my stay in school, the Church paid my school fees. Though some challenges arose during my stay in school, I didn't give up. I did few jobs to support myself in school. God's grace saw me through school and I cleared all my courses. Today, I am a graduate. Getting ready to go for National Youth Service by God's grace.
