In 2024, Pastor (Pastor Kech) was preaching in Church, and she made this statement "We have history with God in TCC".

It caught my attention, and I reflected on it for a long time - and appreciated that statement deeply. Indeed, we all have history with God in TCC. I have history with God in TCC.

I grew up in a family where my siblings always came 1st, 2nd or 3rd in primary school. My case was different as I mostly came last in class. Due to my poor academic performance, my parents will look at my siblings' report cards first and I would see them summon courage to look at my report card after joyfully going through my siblings' (expecting to again see my poor academic results).

I remember (in primary school) telling my parents that a goat ate my report card as I was too ashamed to take my report card home - I destroyed it on my way home from school. They went to school and got another copy. My parents changed my primary school and it made no difference to my scores. I was returned to my previous primary school. I lost all my confidence.

At the age of 9, I started to sell drinks in the streets - at the instance of my parents. In retrospect, I believe my parents had given up on me academically - hence their sending me to learn trading in the streets. I did common entrance in primary 6 and failed woefully (no school in the locality, state, nor national wanted to admit me because of my extremely poor grades - so I ended up attending afternoon school where school finished at about 7pm/8pm (with all sorts of characters in my class).

I made attempts to learn English by reading the dictionary on my own, to know how to pronounce words. I however got into casino gambling at the age of 12 - encouraged by seasoned gamblers (grown up men) who

funded my gambling. I changed secondary school twice - and successfully completed secondary school.

Between 12 and 21 years, 2 of my wrong and close friends died from cocaine (1 trafficked in his abdomen and it bursts, 1 died from usage) and 1 served 24 years jail term in the US - making a total of 3 of my friends. I did not use nor sell drugs, but my close friends and some of their fathers did drugs.

I struggled to finish University and ended with middle level results and shockingly got posted to PH. I say, shockingly because I wanted Lagos and my friend's father was very influential with NYSC and he had assured me that Lagos posting was a done deal. My friend got Lagos for NYSC. We hence parted ways. I did not know that I was on a trajectory for good change (PH) - where I subsequently got born again. I came to TCC and got taught the undiluted and transforming word.

Through God's mercies, I have a career where I am making great impact, a scholarship funded MBA degree at the world's #1 Business school at that time (and still one of the top global business schools). I completed my MBA on schedule with good grades. I have travelled widely across the world delivering first class solutions for intractable problems for the organization I work for - through the help of Holy Spirit who gives me the specific solutions to the work problems.

My school mates (primary, secondary, first degree in the University) who - of course - know my past, sometimes make jokes about me: such as "see this John oo that was the worst/ "Olodo" in our class". We all jokingly laugh about those past 'facts' but i then tell them that it not me but Christ who lives in me that is manifesting the positive results they see.

Indeed, we all have history with God in TCC.
